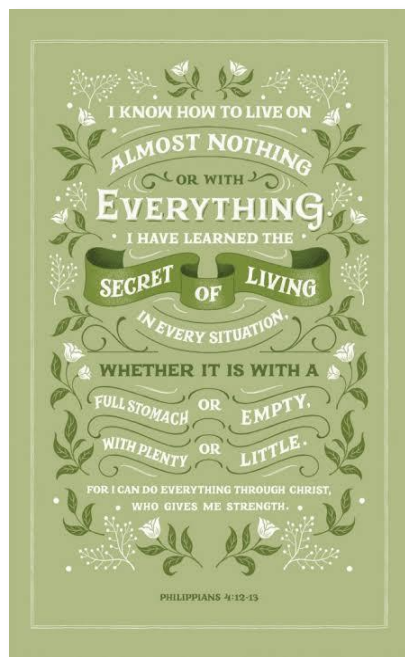
As we continue our journey through Philippians this Sunday, we'll discover how a heart transformed by Jesus naturally begins to overflow into every area of life.
