

We've been aware lately of 2 women of faith who had a great impact on their families. In this passage from Paul's letter to Timothy, we continue this theme. I remember your genuine faith, for you share the faith that first filled your grandmother Lois and your mother, Eunice. And I know that same faith continues strong in you.

2 Timothy 1:5 (NLT)



Stewart writes – Last Sunday we completed our month long teaching theme; 'Jesus Christ – The Fullness of God'. A big 'thank you' to Frank and Paul who helped and shared great messages in this past month. Last Sunday I shared the first of these messages out at Wainui Beach Vineyard Church, as they too are following this great theme. Now this morning, I read this delightful '29 September Devotion' by Charles Spurgeon, which provides a gem for meditating upon...

'To Glorify Christ Jesus'

"He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you." (John 16:14)

The Holy Spirit Himself cannot better glorify the Lord than by showing to us Christ's own things. Jesus is His own best commendation. There is no adorning Him except with His own gold. The Comforter shows us that which He has received of our Lord Jesus. He has a way of opening our minds and of opening the Scriptures, and by this double process He sets forth our Lord to us. He shows us the things themselves and this is a great privilege. Let us seek the illumination of the Spirit, not to gratify our curiosity, or to bring personal comfort, but to glorify the Lord Jesus. Oh to have worthy ideas of Him; to have such vivid impressions of His person, work, and glory that we may with heart and soul cry out His praise! Where there is a heart enriched by the Holy Spirit's teaching, there will be a Saviour glorified beyond expression.
