'Christ & Waitangi' – With 'Waitangi Day' on Tuesday this week, we take the opportunity this morning to share some thoughts and pray for peaceful rememberance and celebrations. Christianity/the Church in NZ has an amazing story to tell in the early history of our nation, but many do not want to know it. The Gospel was invited by Maori – not



imposed, and The Gospel was spread by Māori to Māori, throughout the length of our nation. This amidst poor behavours of many European whalers and traders, before before politics and colonisation issues saw 'Te Tiriti O Waitangi' 'The Treaty' put in place and first Missionaries playing a vital role in that. Dr Stuart Lange of the NZ Christian Network says, "*Christians should neither disregard nor distort the Treaty, nor deify it. It was a governmental document, not a religious document. But we do well to remember that among other things it reflected Christian biblical values of justice, order and human equality.*" The topic of The Treaty today is a sensitive one. Perhaps too politicised? Meanwhile we must focus on what is most important. As the Church, we have a story to tell. Our job is to lift Jesus Christ up to the people.
