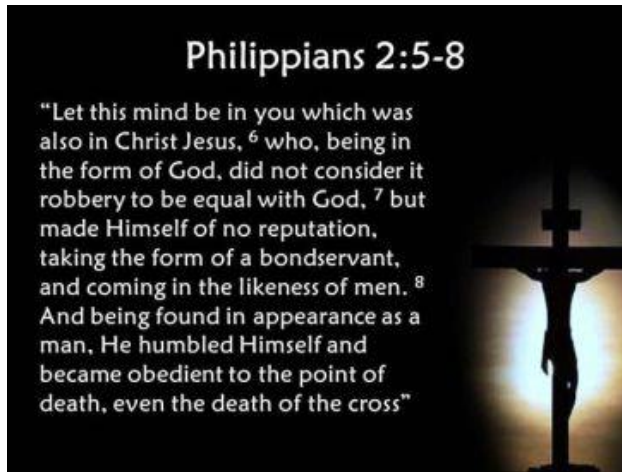

Throughout the Gospels we see Jesus, the incarnate God, stepping out of heaven, coming down to earth and revealing himself to man.

Paul, in his letters to the Philippians, writes of the character of Jesus that this reveals. Jesus, fully God, yet not grasping for that glory, instead humble and obedient in taking on the form of man. Throughout his letter Paul points to that as the way we are to live, no matter the circumstances. Because of that, though written from a Roman jail, it is a letter full of joy.
