

MUP Re-Roofing Project

The final work of flashings and spouting is being done, and the A&F Team are delighted to

advise that we will be receiving a \$50,000 grant from the Methodist Properties Development Grant Fund. This is wonderful news as there was quite a lot of work to put that application together in a short time. We just have to have the paperwork for asbestos removal signed off from the subcontractor and work out a plan for the internal ceiling repairs, with asbestos checks there too.

Wes Nomell of Rapcon Roofing, has kept us up to date all the way through and says, "We are installing the additional flashings now. This is why you had the leaks (in creche). Roof ends are bad. Our new flashing will be much longer, but expect a new roof at some point. The rust will just keep

going." (See pic). So A&F Team will be looking at a time frame for when the back roof may need to be done too.

A funny moment this week - when the Roofer opened up the section where a leak was bad, he found this 10 litre plastic bucket in the roof cavity, full to the brim! Someone put it there many years ago, because of the leak. Anyone recognize the bucket? ©
