

Stewart writes... Colleen Mounsey shared beautifully, deeply and very personally last Sunday morning and everyone here at MUP was so blessed by her testimony and message. Sadly there was a glitch in the recording of this, so we do not have it available.



Here are some special thoughts Colleen shared, on the past 8 months since Bruce's passing...

- Isaiah 54:5, "For your Maker is your husband, the LORD of hosts is His name". In the first difficult days of Bruce's passing, Colleen was looking for the verse in Isaiah that called Bruce to preach, but this verse leapt from the page before her. A precious personal word and promise that will carry her through her days now that Bruce her husband has gone to be with Him.
- 'Your word will be your legacy' Bruce received that personal word from a Guest preacher at a large Church in London some 15 years ago. Colleen is seeing that come to pass in several ways.
- **Family restored** Colleen's brother has seen restored relationships in his family/children, as a result of Bruce's passing.
- Colleen's miraculous health recoveries On two occasions Colleen has been admitted to hospital unwell, and received dire prognoses each time, but she also had 'peace' each time. Both times the 'further tests' have revealed nothing! The week prior to coming to us, Colleen was in hospital and could not talk. It was thought she had suffered a stroke. But tests revealed nothing, and here she was, sharing with us just days later. Thank you Lord!
- Prayer When Colleen was told a scan had revealed a large dark mass in her abdomen, she had peace, and only told her Womens' Prayer Group to pray for her. One woke at 3am in the morning with a vision of a hand reaching into Colleen and removing something. It was after this all further tests revealed nothing. We pray and ask for prayer from others, in every situation.
