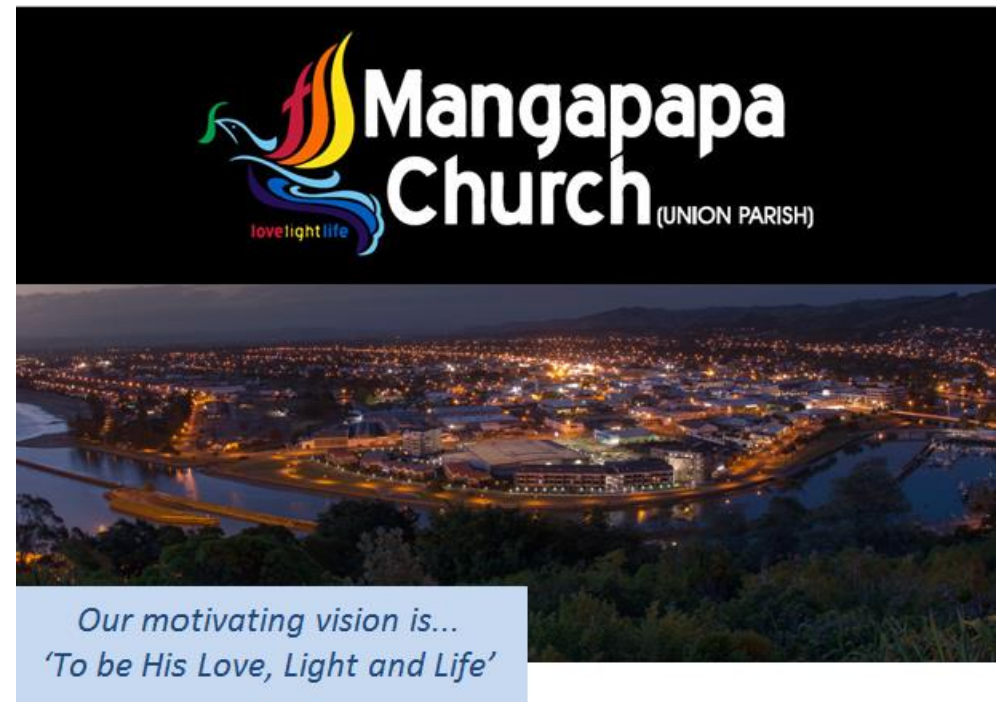
Women's 'Growth Group' – Meets fortnightly on Thursdays at 1pm in the Church House.
