Frank Darcy shares the message with us this morning. He writes ...

In my last message, I talked about Christ's coming as the "Parousia" (a state visit) of Christ coming to earth. Then we live with him forever in the Holy City, the New Jerusalem.

My title this morning is "A House in Heaven." In 2 Cor. 5:1-8, we learn what this "house" actually is.

In these verses, Paul treats the state between death and the resurrection as insignificant. He skips over it, concentrating instead on the more important issue of the resurrection.

What Paul does look forward to is Jesus' return, when he will be away from his present suffering (this mortal body), and at home with the (returned, triumphant, sovereign) Lord in his glorified body. That is the hope he describes in verse 8. That is our hope also.
