<u>A Reminder of our current Service attendance requirements</u> <u>from this Sunday</u> – NZ is under RED, due to Omicron spreading. We are warned that there will be difficult weeks ahead, so *what changes are required for our Sunday Services over the next 2 months?*

- Masks Masks will be compulsory at our Services from this Sunday 7th Feb. (Note: Worship Team, leaders and preachers when at the front, are not required to wear their masks).
- 2) Morning Tea Although we are still legally able to serve tea and coffee at Services under RED, we decided that once we started getting confirmed cases in the Gisborne region then we won't be having morning tea/coffee. That has happened, so *no Morning Teas for a while*.
- 3) Offerings These will be received at the door where folk can drop them into a bucket/basket when entering. Greeters will oversee the offering.
- 4) Communion Cups are all disposable, and if servers have gloves and masks then serving is easy with the seating spaced 1 metre apart. Collecting of used cups will be done by the servers to avoid excess handling.
- 5) Closing Services, Live Streaming only We are doing this every Sunday now, and if we find Omicron is progressing rapidly in the community, we will
