In Matthew 18 Jesus says this:

Jesus had told them that when they came together in His name, He would be there, and that when they agreed together in His name, He would hear their prayers and perform miracles. No wonder the instinct of the early church, whenever they faced trials, was simply to raise their voices together and intercede.

As we finish our learning from the Prayer Course, and as we are seeking ways to put this into practise more and more, please join us this Tuesday 14 May, 7pm in the Church to pray together. We aim to be finished by 8:15pm and would love as many as possible to come.
