Frank writes:

What is God like? Frank will be speaking on two themes this morning:

- God is eternal and unchanging.
- God is absolutely fair and just.

These two qualities raise certain questions as to why God permitted all the violence recorded in the Old Testament. How do we explain the book of Joshua when the Israelites were instructed to "destroy them all?"

(Shorter Catechism) - "God is a Spirit, infinite, eternal and unchangeable in His being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness and truth."

Ex. 34:6-7 - "Yahweh, Yahweh is God, merciful and compassionate, slow to anger rich in grace and truth, showing grace to the thousandth generation, forgiving offences, crimes and sins. But I also punish the guilty."

Deut. 32:3-4 - "Ascribe greatness to our God, the Rock, His work is perfect and all His ways are just. A God of faithfulness and without injustice, good and upright is He."

Is the God of the Old Testament really the same as the God of the New? Is He also "the same yesterday and forever"?
