This morning we continue looking at Paul's letter to the Ephesians, which many of our home services were based on during lock down. As we begin chapter four, Paul speaks about three important things in our Christian growth: character, unity and gifts.

- **Character:** Living lives worthy of our calling, being humble, gentle and patient.
- **Unity:** Making every effort to be united and to make allowances for others faults and differences.
- **Gifts:** Discovering and using our God given gifts to glorify God and so the body can function with all its parts.

I love how character and gifts are almost always talked about side by side. Just as God works in us, chiselling away to make us more like Christ, He also gifts and equips us so we can all take our part in seeing His Kingdom grow.

How well do you understand what your gifts are? Maybe take some time this week to reflect on this, and ask others for feedback if you are stuck. Knowing your gifts isn't to make you proud, it is so you can serve God well. And great joy comes from discovering our gifts and using them. This is how we are designed. And each one of us has a unique part to play.

This Sunday night I encourage you to join the Combined Churches event at House of Breakthrough at 6pm. This will be a worship celebration with Alfred Ngaro speaking. It will be a great opportunity for us to gather and pray together in Unity for our city, nation and world. It will be followed by a shared supper.
