

Paula writes...

Today we are thinking a little about Mary. Quite incredible, that although she is such a key character, we know so little about her. When we read the story – the obvious question is, 'Why did she have God's favour?' Our guess is it was her heart for God, her humility, her trust and her willingness to obey a pretty unique and challenging call.

Finding favour with God is not something we can make happen. What we can do is develop a soft heart toward God and others, and be developing character, humility, kindness. Being faithful in the small things – and who knows when God may surprise us?

Finding favour might sound like an amazing thing, but it wasn't easy. It meant being called to take on a very specific role in His plan – a key and difficult one. When God wants to use someone for His purposes, it will often seem impossible. But God's power will be with us to make the impossible possible.



God's favour is powerful but it is also challenging and demanding. Mary's response was initially hesitant, but then a committed YES. "Let it be as you have said". When God finds favour with us, it's because He wants to use us for His purposes. That almost always comes with pretty significant demands on our time, our money, our entire lifestyle. But Mary's response is fitting, "I am the Lord's servant."

I wonder whether God has, or is, speaking to you about a specific role or calling he has? And if so, are you running like Jonah, giving excuses like Moses, or are you ready to say YES like Mary despite the cost? Challenging!

Thanks to so many who have agreed to help for our 'Carols on the Lawn' next Saturday. Please see Nicola if you would like a role and haven't already joined a team. We would love others of you to just come and bring friends. Please be praying that this would be a real blessing to all who come, to our neighbourhood, and that the Jesus story would be shared with gentleness and clarity.

And may you, in the busyness and lead-up to Christmas, be bearers of peace and blessing to those stressed and struggling.
