For Prayer this week - Ken & Alison McFarlane report - Sadness as lives lost in floods on their first night back in Loi Tai Leng Village!

We got back to Chiangmai about two weeks ago after spending some time with our son and daughter in law and grandson in Bunbury, W.A. After some time organising ourselves we have now managed to cross



the border into Loi Tai Leng village in Myanmar. This ended up being straight forward (even though the official border crossings are still closed). We arrived in time for the graduation ceremony of a group of Community Health Workers who had been trained by local staff. Some of these will go on to form our medic one class. After a lovely evening of celebration, it rained very heavily for about two hours. This caused a disastrous flash flood destroying several houses on the valley floor. Four people were killed, including one of our Shan teachers and our friend, as well as one and the newly graduated CHW students. It has been a very sad couple of days here. We are planning to return to Chiangmai tomorrow, to get the things we need to repair the house and additional teaching resources, and then go back to the village in ten days time to start teaching.
