



## Paula writes...

Two weeks ago I mentioned a song I had learned over lock down. The song is based on Daniel 3, the passage we look at this week. Sometimes we think we know the Bible stories, especially the well-known ones. But I love it how when we reread we see new things.



This story is incredible. Three

Jewish men who, in a simple act of faithfulness to God, were dobbed in by jealous associates and faced the consequences of an arrogant and power obsessed King. It seems they were faithful servants in other ways but then were presented with a situation and a boundary they would not cross.

## Their words are amazing:

"King Nebuchadnezzar, we do not need to defend ourselves before you in this matter. <sup>17</sup> If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and he will deliver us from Your Majesty's hand. <sup>18</sup> But even if he does not, we want you to know, Your Majesty, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up."

What happens next is mind-blowing. Read through Daniel 3!

Their faithfulness to God stands out – but much greater is God's faithfulness to them. They were willing to obey, even if God didn't rescue them. And as amazing as the rescue was - is what everyone who was watching saw, including the KING.

They were not alone – there was another being in the fire with them!

So whether you are facing particular challenges because of circumstances, or because you are living in a way that is faithful to Jesus even when it goes against those around you – may you know you are not alone. Even if your situation is unresolved.

God of the incarnation, God who became human and lived with us, God of the Emmaus Rd who walks beside, God who is in the boat in the storm. We are not alone.

There was another in the fire
Standing next to me
There was another in the waters
Holding back the seas
And should I ever need reminding
Of how I've been set free
There is a cross that bears the burden
Where another died for me.
