



Paula writes...

Some words that have been speaking to me this week come from 1 Peter 3:

¹⁵ Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. ¹⁶ But do this in a gentle and respectful way. Keep your conscience clear. Then if people speak against you, they will be ashamed when they see what a good life you live because you belong to Christ. ¹⁷ Remember, it is better to suffer for doing good, if that is what God wants, than to suffer for doing wrong!



Whether it is in personal relationships or in a more public sphere, our words matter. Are we able to explain what we believe and why, are we able to make comment on issues that concern us in our community and culture, and are we able to do this with wisdom, gentleness and respect? And do our lives match up to our words? Challenging questions.

While attending the Family First Conference a few weeks ago, I was reminded of the challenge and responsibility of keeping up to date with current issues so that we can think through Christian responses and participate in helpful and respectful debate in the public sphere. Not only can this make a difference to how we speak and vote into the governance and policy of our country but also in institutions like schools and workplaces. It also helps us as we engage with friends and colleagues on complex issues of our time.

One new resource that I would encourage you to look at is Active Intelligence. Here Aaron Ironside aims to speak to a wide range of issues in a balanced way. Recently he has covered topics as diverse as climate change, the Palestinian and Israel conflict, bitcoin, cannabis, transgenderism and sport, and the Covid vaccine.

Join Aaron Ironside as he tackles the issues of the day and brings you, the viewer,

to a deeper understanding of both sides of significant social debates. Active Intelligence is a place where you can find balance not bias. No one will tell you what to think or dismiss you if you have concerns about social trends.
