

Bible 2020, the world's largest Bible reading campaign, is only 9 days away. Bible 2020 is about Christians all over the world downloading a smartphone app and receiving a Scripture passage each day. Participants will be able to



record themselves speaking the passage out loud and upload it to the global video wall. They can then watch people from all over the world reading that same passage in their heart language. This is a unique opportunity to join with thousands of Christians and help cover the whole of God's world with God's Word. And what's even better is that the whole global campaign kicks off in Gisborne at sunrise on January 1st!



The Bible Society will be at Okitu Beach at 5.30am to film the first readings for this global campaign as the sun rises. They will be joined by the campaign founder from the Bible Society of Scotland, and they'd love to see you there to be part of this historic moment. There will be BBQ facilities so bring your bacon and

They'd love to have you join and help with the Scripture reading, as they want to have a strong start to this global campaign with as many people as possible uploading videos of the passage that morning.
