## Paula writes....

Have you ever been in an embarrassing situation where you miscommunicated because of a cultural difference? I have many stories! © When we consider sharing the good news of Jesus, this is a relevant question because our context contains many cultures, and even our kiwi



culture has shifted so far that many assumptions, such as the existence of truth, are much less widely held than even 10 years ago. If you are not from a Christian background, I wonder how long was your own journey from disinterested in Christ to faith in Christ, and at what point in that journey did you hear and understand the gospel? This is another relevant guestion as we seek to engage with people on issues of spirituality, life purpose and hope for a future. Demonstrating love and acceptance of where a person is at, is also so key to beginning conversations of deeper life issues where trust really matters.

Today we continue to focus on the Conversations of Jesus - this time from the gospel of Mark chapter 10. As I have prepared this week I have been blown away again by Jesus' skill and heart - in both demonstrating love yet deeply challenging those he came across. In just one chapter we have his demonstration of love to children, despite everyone else's annoyance. We have an amazing and deeply challenging interaction with the rich man who longed to know how to gain eternal life. And we have the transformational healing of blind Bartimaeus - the beggar who others wanted to be quiet.

I invite you to enter into these stories and let them challenge you and change you. Imagine how you would have responded to Jesus then, and more importantly how to respond to Him now.
