Paula writes....

This week we dive into the six-week *Prayer Course* in Sunday sermons and weekday small groups. This course is one means to explore further how we "grow in God" this year. My heart is that at the end, each of us

would be praying not just more often but with more confidence and focus – and that we would see God at work.

A survey of more than 800 full-time pastors in the USA revealed that 84% of them were discontent with their prayer life. And I don't think it's just Pastors....! Henri Nouwen, a well-known author and priest wrote, "Prayer is the essence of the spiritual life, without which all ministry loses its meaning. It is the fulfilment of The Great Commandment...."

Thankfully the disciples acknowledged their inadequacy in prayer and one day asked Jesus, "Lord, teach us to pray." Jesus didn't rebuke them or put them down for their question, and he will not do that to us either! He simply responded by giving his followers the prayer that is prayed regularly by more than a third of the world's population. The Lord's Prayer is the basis of this course.

The course-writers suggest that there are at least four great myths about prayer that are lurking in the hearts and minds of Christ-followers that will be addressed in this course:

Myth 1: That everyone else is praying more than you.

Truth 1: We all need help.

Myth 2: Prayer always works if I do it right.

Truth 2: Even Jesus lives with unanswered prayer.

Myth 3: God will do what He wants whether or not we pray.

Truth 3: Our prayers can be a matter of life and death.

Myth 4: Some people are naturals at prayer while I will always struggle.

Truth 4: You can become someone who sees miracles in answer to prayer.

Because no one is born a prayer warrior, we can all be better at prayer! God has so much more for us than we currently experience or understand. Because the course-presenters themselves struggle with prayer, it is good to know the above myths and challenges of prayer will be addressed, and there will be time to share our struggles and questions.

If we come with humble hearts asking, "Lord, teach ME to pray", then I believe that God will respond by transforming prayer from a guilty 'should' at which we are

forever failing, into an exciting 'could' which is accessible, enjoyable and powerful for everyone who loves Him. Let us all join in this prayer today....

Lord, I often talk more about you than to you and I'm sorry. I pray for my own prayer life to grow. I pray for prayers to be answered through this course. I pray for complacency to be replaced by expectancy and disappointment by fresh faith; that those who don't see themselves as pray-ers will be quietly hijacked by your Spirit. Lord, we long for more of your presence, your perspective and your power in our lives. Would you please teach us to pray? Amen
