



Frank Darcy shares with us this morning from the Book of Hebrews:

The book of Hebrews was written to explain how God's plan moved from the Old Testament to the New Testament and how Christ had fulfilled the OT prophecies. This was because some of the Jewish Christians were beginning to lapse back into Judaism. In the book there are five strong warnings given about the dangers of abandoning the true faith:

• 2:1-4

• 3:7 - 4:13

6:1-20

• 10:19-39

• 12:1-29

The letter emphasises that things are better now since the coming of Christ:

- Jesus is greater than angels (1:5-2:18)
- Greater than Moses and Joshua (3:1-4:13)
- Jesus is the Great High Priest (4:14-7:28)
- In Christ, we have a better covenant (8:1-9:22)
- Jesus' sacrifice is once and for all (9:23-10:31)
- Faith is the better way (10:19-12:29)

In Ch. 12, we are urged to "run the race." What does that mean for us in our Christian walk today?
