Today we begin our journey through the book of Philippians following Jim's introduction a few weeks ago. This letter written from prison celebrates friendship, speaks of how to live joyfully in the face of suffering and challenges us to live differently as Citizens of heaven. As I have been reading Chapter One this week, I have been thinking a lot about what it means to be a good citizen. This is particularly relevant as we also reflect on the election results and the future of our country.



Above all, you must live as citizens of heaven, conducting yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ. Then, whether I come and see you again or only hear about you, I will know that you are standing together with one spirit and one purpose, fighting together for the faith, which is the Good News. Philippians 1:27

As New Zealand citizens (for those of us who are) we have rights and responsibilities. But as followers of lesus we are also citizens of Heaven

Jesus we are also citizens of Heaven – we have dual citizenship. There are incomparable advantages to this heavenly citizenship, yet there are also responsibilities or duties.
