

Finally, if you would be willing to host or lead a small group for 6 weeks at the beginning of next term when we do a church wide study, please let Paula know.






Leadership Team – We are still looking for another person to be on the Leadership Team, so if you would like to nominate someone to be considered for this position, please email the office or let Paula know.
