



THE LEAST OF THESE

Famous last words – on the Mount of Olives, just days before Jesus was betrayed, tried and crucified, He speaks to his disciples using three parables. This is His last series of messages before He dies - it is vital we understand what He's wanting to convey in these final words and that we use the right lens to view these important verses and then apply them to our life.
