

Frank Darcy writes ...

Ephesians 2:10 – "For we (the Church) are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago."

In the Tyndale New Testament Commentary, we read these words:

"In many respects Ephesians...is like a sermon on the greatest and widest theme possible for a Christian sermon – the eternal purpose of God, which He Is fulfilling through his Son Jesus Christ, and working out in and through the Church. One thought leads to another all the way through.

Chapters 1-3 are principally the doctrinal elaboration of the great theme, and Chapters 4-6 teach what should be the practical consequences of it for human life and relationships. There is, however, no elaborate division between doctrine and ethics, but rather an intimate linking of the two throughout."

Where is the man who is so ordinary, that in his assessment of himself, he sees himself as nothing? Nothing. We sometimes ask the children, "What gets bigger the more you take from it?" own eyes has a great God. But the man who becomes nothing in his own eyes knows God as He is. (by Arthur Burt, from "How To Be Ordinary.")


