Church Services Under the new Covid Traffic Light System

From Friday 3 December, NZ moves to this new Covid Alert Level strategy, when the Auckland border will reopen to the rest of NZ. This will mean changes to numbers who can attend



Church Services/activities and those numbers vary depending on whether it is 1) a mixed vaccinated & unvaccinated persons gathering, or ... 2) a solely vaccinated persons gathering. Not until Monday evening will we know for sure where Gisborne/Tairawhiti district will start in this system, but Gisborne Herald reports suggest it may be the **RED Level** that we commence on, because of our district's low vaccination rates. Your Elders and Leadership Team will be meeting 7pm on Wednesday 1st December to work through how we will operate under these new conditions. Just today we have received comprehensive 'Covid 19 Protection Framework Guidelines' from our oversite (Presbyterian Church of NZ), to assist us in this process. We will let you know on Thursday morning by email and on the MUP Facebook Page, and in next week's Newsletter out on Friday, what has been decided. A slim chance that 'outdoor mixed gatherings' may be allowed with greater numbers attending ... but there are no guarantees. Whatever Government decides on Monday around 'gatherings/events', we will need to be and will seek to be, creative and flexible with our Worship Services, whatever level we are in, while still adhering to the Pandemic mandates. This is a time of heightened stress for all, knowing that Covid 19 will inevitably be in our District soon and working with these temporary pandemic restrictions. Let us all keep our peace, trusting in Him... from your Elders Team.
