

#### Paula writes...

How have you gone getting into some kind of Bible plan this week? I have been struck again, how what at first may seem a specific word to Israel 3000 years ago, can speak to my specific situation today and encourage or challenge or direct.

Sometimes we struggle with parts of the Old Testament. It may be easier to go straight for the words of Jesus. Maybe we think the God we experience in Jesus is a bit easier to "like". But in doing so we are in




danger of worshipping an idol we have made, not the awesome, amazing and true God.

There is so much "gold" in the full picture of scripture: Genesis to Revelation. The God of the Old and the New is the same. And this God is so much more amazing than we can imagine. It is a huge danger to in any way try and make God into something He is not, to make Him in our image or what we think we would like Him to be!

Sometimes our world has tried to humanize God, and reduce Him to be more "palatable". But our God is infinitely greater, more powerful, more majestic than we can comprehend. And yet He is also loving and merciful and just.

For the next 5 weeks we are going to focus our teaching on some of the attributes of God, particularly as are found in the Old Testament and especially the Psalms, the Old Testament songs and poems of worship. As we do, my prayer is our hearts would be filled with wonder and awe that such a God should stoop to save and love us. And that we would be more and more blown away and drawn to worship and trust Him as our knowledge of who He is, expands and grows.
