

Today we will be providing an overview of Paul's Letter to the Philippians. This overview will cover both the letter itself as well as other important details about this church found in Acts 15:36 – 17:15 and 2 Co 8:1 – 5. I would encourage you to read these passages alongside the letter. We intend to cover one chapter of the letter in detail over the coming few weeks.
