

Welcome to the second Sunday in Advent and a Family Service where all ages can participate. Please stay and join us for lunch afterwards.

Isaiah 40:3-5 says this: "A voice of one calling: 'In the wilderness prepare the way for the Lord; make straight in the desert." Mark used these words again of John the Baptist preparing the way for Jesus. So how do we prepare to "welcome" Jesus as we re-tell His story this Christmas season. This week of advent the focus is preparation. Here is one reflection I read:

"So what is the message as we prepare for the faith-deepening experience of the Birth of Jesus? The message is the same as John preached to the Jews: "Prepare by seeking forgiveness." What gets in the way of our appreciating God's gift of Jesus as Saviour can be that we have let idols clutter our lives as the Jews of old did. Does our abundance, our need for recognition, and our longing for security become ends and not means? Have they become the little idols we worship? So John invites us to transformation of heart by acknowledging and confessing our sins so we can be attentive to the true "reason for the season." Is there anything you need to put right to help you celebrate well Jesus coming into our world this year?"
