

I am away this weekend for "The Gathering", a meeting of Presbyterian leaders from Central Presbytery (the bottom half of the North Island). This includes a speaker, workshops and time to pray and connect.

Thanks to all those who attended our CARE training last weekend. It was a great opportunity to learn together and grapple with some of the challenges of caring for people well. We have much we can take from it to integrate into our church and individual lives. We talked about structured care: setting up good systems of pastoral care and support as a church (home groups, visiting, practical support, financial help, discipleship etc), as well as organic care: the care we give one another as we take the time to notice and respond. We are a body of many parts and we are called to care for one another. Thank you for all the ways you do this; through a phone call, a visit, a meal, a gift, a prayer or simply taking the time to listen.

#### **LEADERSHIP UPDATE:**

As mentioned last week, we have decided to do a monthly Leadership Update to enable you as our Church Family to be more aware of what is happening at a Leadership level, what are the important things we are considering, and how you can have input.

Our Elders meet around once a month, as well as praying every second Saturday. Our current Elders are Andrew Russell, Llew Paul, Rodney Judd, myself and two associate Elders: Anna Alder and Al Clements. Our current Leadership team is the Elders, as well Bill Wheeler and Dione Russell, Debbie Dobbie and Neil Smoker. We meet every 6 weeks.
