


Mountain Biking in Wairoa - this afternoon!

Thanks to all those who helped with our OPEN Shed Day last weekend. It was a joy to pray and work together with our House of Breakthrough neighbours and a privilege to bless many in the community. Please pray seeds of love and hope that were sown will begin to germinate.

This morning we have Ken and Alison McFarlane teaching. This awesome couple have been serving God in New Zealand, Thailand and in Myanmar over many years. Currently they are trusting God in limbo as they have not been able to return to Thailand and Myanmar, and future plans are almost impossible to make. May we learn from their courage and stories and pray for the people and situations they have not been able to return to. May we also pray for them in this period of uncertainty, that God works through them in many ways in this place.

As citizens of God's kingdom, we are called to love, worship, and obey our Lord, to love and serve His body, the Church, and to love all peoples everywhere, which includes presenting the whole gospel for the whole person throughout the whole world.

We believe in God–Father, Son and Holy Spirit–and that the Bible is God's inspired and authoritative Word, revealing that Jesus Christ is God's son, fully God and fully human; that people are created in God's image; that He created us to have eternal life through Jesus Christ; that although all people have sinned and come short of God's glory, God has made salvation possible through the incarnation, life, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ; that repentance, faith, love and obedience are fitting responses to God's initiative of grace towards us through the active ministry of the Holy Spirit; that God desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth; and that the Holy Spirit's power is demonstrated in and through us for the accomplishment of Christ's last commandments, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to everyone" (Mark 16:15 NLT) and "Go and make disciples of all the nations..."
