


Stewart writes... In part 2 of this series on 'Understanding Deceptions', it is important that I clarify again - we are talking about Satan's strategies and schemes to deceive 'believers', which are

Let's talk about how we enter that place of rest and how we can be deceived from entering, or kept from re-entering, by footholds of our enemy. **Ephesians 4:27 AMP** "Leave no room or foothold for the devil [give no opportunity to him]."
