**Stewart writes...** James Carstens shares with us this morning his unique personal testimony and teaching, gleaned from his life lessons, with and without Christ and God at the centre of his life. James has had a life of caring for people at the extremes of their existence – first as a young anaesthetist in the huge Baragwanath Hospital at the time of the riots in the 1970's in Johannesburg. Then establishing a Pain Clinic here at Gisborne Hospital, followed by the Palliative Care Service here in Gisborne in the 1980's. And now in different ways this caring continues in James & Wendy's 'retirement' years, with discipleship counsel that he and Wendy undertake, as the Lord brings people across their paths. As part of his message, James has prepared this 'Handout' in the Newsletter today; – 'WHAT ARE THE RESULTS OF HAVING A NEW LIFE IN CHRIST?' and his message notes are available too, just ask him if you want a copy.
